

Green Procurement Policy

I. Purpose

In order to minimise adverse impacts on the environment, the Green Procurement Policy states that Synnex will endeavor to purchase environmentally preferred products made from recycled content unless such products do not perform satisfactorily and/or are unreasonably expensive and not competitive.

This policy supports the recycling hierarchy of reduce-reuse-recycle through minimizing the creation of waste, reusing materials, recycling materials that cannot be source-reduced, and purchasing recycled content and environmentally preferred products.

II. Policy

To achieve Synnex's objectives to green procurement, we recognise the need to act proactively by carrying out purchasing activities in an environmentally responsible manner.

We commit to:

- comply with all relevant environmental legislation
- encourage and persuade suppliers to investigate and introduce environmentally friendly processes and products
- educate our suppliers about Synnex's commitment to reducing negative impact on the environment
- ensure our suppliers' environmental credentials are considered in the supplier appraisal process
- ensure where appropriate, environmental criteria are used in the award of contracts
- wherever possible and reasonably practicable, advocate the use of environmentally preferred materials, products and services
- ensure that consideration is given to inclusion, within all specifications, of a facility for potential suppliers to submit tenders for environmentally innovative products and services
- ensure appropriate consideration is given to the costs and benefits of environmentally preferred alternatives.
